Natura Onecoat WOOD OIL 2K

General Features:

- Creates bonds among the upper fibers of the wood.
- Doesn't create a film layer on the surface.
- Bonding among the fibers provides protection against heat and water.
- Preserves the natural look.
- Prolongs the durability of the wood.
- VOC-free.
- Could be used on all wooden surfaces.
- Applied as a single coat.
- Packaging: 140 ml, 360 ml, 1.3 L

Tecnical Specifications:

Basis	: Mixture of natural oils and waxes.
Physical form	: Liquid.
Density	: Clear: 0.93-0.95 g/cm³; Colors: 1.00-1.40 g/cm³
VOC (2004/42/CE,1999/13/CE)	: 0 g/l
Resistance to water (NEN-EN 13442)	: No visual or tangible changes.
Resistance to wear	: High abrasion and scratch resistance.

Surface Preparation:

Clean the surface thoroughly; remove any dirt and dust from the surface. Sand the surface with 80/120 grit for flooring and 180/220 grit for furniture. Vacuum clean the surface to remove the generated dust and remove the remaining dust with a microfiber cloth.

Application:

- The product is used as two components with a ratio of oil to hardener 3:1. Do not dilute the product.
- Stir well the product before use. Add the hardener to oil and stir the product thoroughly with a spatula or stick. Make sure it is homogenous.
- Apply the mixture within 5-6 hours after preparation.
- 1.3L of product could cover 50-80m2 depending on the wood type and application method.
- Apply the mixture in one coat with a brush or a cloth.
- Applied surface may be stepped on after 24 hours.
- Remove any excess oil with a cloth after a minimum of 3 minutes and no later than 30 minutes, ensuring the surface feels dry. It takes 5 days for full cure.

Safety Precautions:

- CLOTHS THAT ARE SOAKED WITH OIL MAY SPONTANEOUSLY COMBUST. AFTER USAGE, WASH THE CLOTHS WITH WATER BEFORE DISPOSAL!**
- Use with adequate ventilation! Keep out of reach of children!
- Avoid contact with eyes and skin.
- In case of eye contact, flush thoroughly with large amounts of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, call hospital emergency or physician immediately.
